3. Once classes have started, there will be no refunds of registration fees. **If for any reason your child cannot participate after registering for a class, a minimum of two weeks notice must be given in order to receive a full refund, minus a registration fee of \$10.00.**
4. UVAA reserves the right to cancel a scheduled class if minimum registration isn't met. If this occurs, a full refund will be given or your child may transfer to another class, adjusting fees as necessary.
5. A minimum of one-week notice is required to change from one class to another - **There will be no schedule adjustments the week of the registered class.** You will need to contact the Art Center prior to making a class change to assure that your child's name is placed on the correct class roster. If you find it necessary to drop a class and do not find another class of interest, you will forfeit the registration fees.
6. If, for any reason, you foresee being late in picking up your child after his/her class, please call UVAA so we can inform your child. If necessary, please make alternative arrangements.
